

MEMORY MERCHANT

Aims:

This simple activity tests a student's immediate recall of pictorial / geometrical information.

Place a copy of the **accompanying sheet** upon an **OHP**.

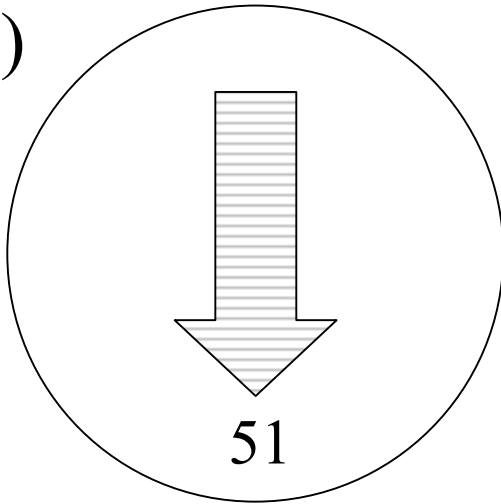
Students are allowed one minute to commit as many details to memory as possible without making any kind of physical notes at all.

After the minute has passed, ask a few questions about the slide which the students can answer in their notebooks etc.

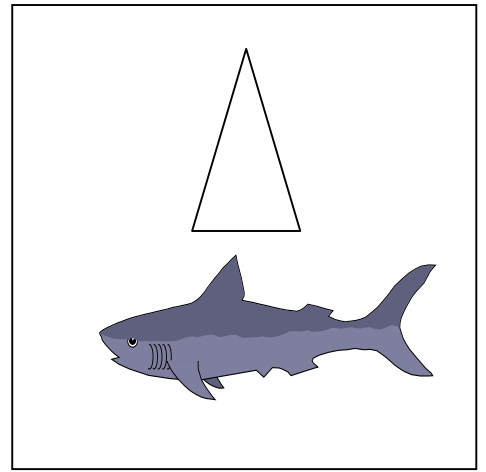
Example questions:

- 1) Which diagram featured a shark?
- 2) Diagram 1 featured a shaded arrow. What kind of shading was used?
- 3) Which eye was shaded in diagram 4?
- 4) How many furrow lines were there in diagram 4?
- 5) Diagram 3 had a number of circles inside a large geometric shape. What kind of shape was used?
- 6) How many of the circles in diagram 3 had crosses inside them?
- 7) How many parcels were there in diagram 6?
- 8) What was the time on the clock in diagram 5?
- 9) How many people were sat around the table in diagram 6?
- 10) What kind of animal was featured in diagram 5?

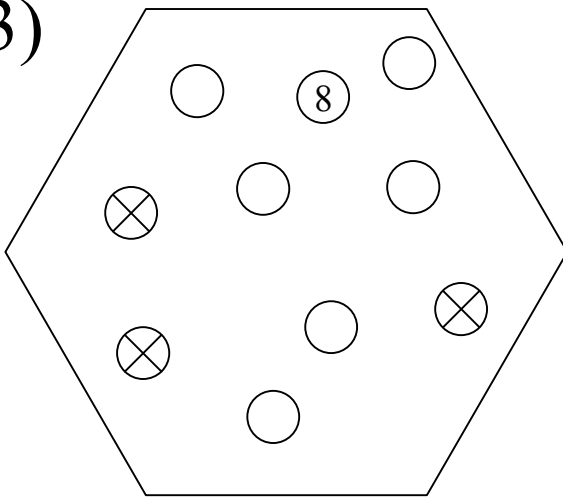

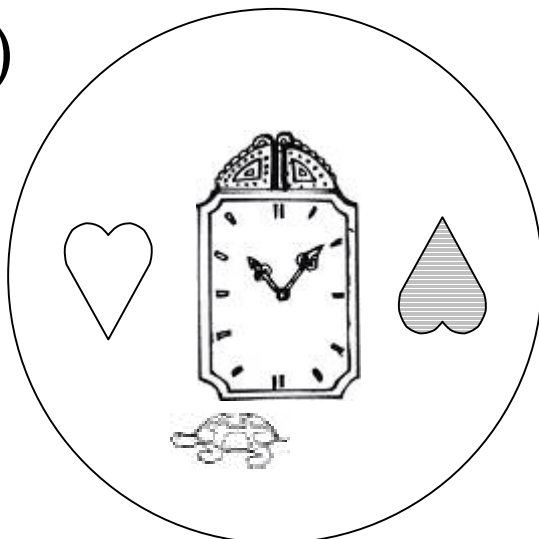
